Sir,

Reference is invited to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 22.9.2005. The funding support under the ongoing Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Project Tiger for carrying out the All India estimation of tiger, large carnivores, ungulate along with habitat status evaluation (2005-2006) in the State of Madhya Pradesh is as below:-

a. Wages

The GPS (@ one per Division) and booklets would be provided by the Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun.

Sanction/release order for above work is enclosed.

2. The Project Tiger Directorate and the Wildlife Institute of India are jointly involved in the process of creating a spatial data-base in the GIS domain for depicting country level tiger / co-predator estimation and habitat status. This requires digitization of the boundaries of forest divisions, forest ranges and forest beats on a 1:50,000 scale. It is requested, a set of such maps pertaining to your State may be sent to this Ministry at the earliest. In case such digitized data is already available at your end, the same may please be made available. In this regard the Addl.DGF (Wildlife) has already requested the Surveyor General, Survey of India for the needful, and a copy of the above letter is appended for ready reference.
3. The spear-head teams receiving training in the regional workshops may please be allowed to carry out capacity building of other field staff in the State, keeping in mind the schedule for field data collection. This Ministry may please be apprised of action taken in this regard including details of field level workshops to be convened.
4. Due economy should be exercised in conducting the estimation keeping in mind the expenditure management drive.
5. No permanent staff should be recruited and the contract labour to be deployed will be kept to the minimum necessary for estimation.
6. It may be ensured that the additional labour and personnel to be deployed do not have any claim to permanent government service, and their tenure may be kept to the minimum necessary duration.
7. The itinerary of national / international peers, who would be overseeing the data collection, would be communicated in due course of time. The Utilisation Certificate pertaining to the Central Assistance provided may please be furnished to this Ministry in the prescribed format after completion of the work.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the administrative approval of the competent authority for carrying out the All India estimation of Tiger, large carnivores, ungulate along with habitat status evaluation (2005-2006) in the state **Madhya Pradesh** at a cost of **Rs. 60.6376 lakhs** (Rupees Sixty lakhs sixty three thousand seven hundred and sixty only) as per details given in the annexure. The cost of the scheme will be treated as 100% Central Assistance by the Government of India.

2. I am also directed to convey the sanction of the competent authority to the release of an amount of **Rs. 60.6376 lakhs** (Rupees Sixty lakhs sixty three thousand seven hundred and sixty only) to Government of **Madhya Pradesh**.

3. The payment sanctioned above is provisional and is subject to the adjustment on the basis of the audited figures of expenditure. Other terms and conditions of the payment are as under:

- a) The grant is in accordance with the pattern of financial assistance approved by the Planning Commission and the Ministry of Finance.
- b) The grant sanctioned is subject to the adjustment on the basis of the terms and conditions approving the scheme.

4. No deviation from the approved items of expenditure as enumerated in the annexure shall be made without prior concurrence of the Government of India. The Chief

Wildlife warden and the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests of the State Government are required to ensure that the estimation of tiger wild animals and habitat evaluation works are in accordance with the directives issued by the Project Tiger Division of the Ministry of Environment & Forests.

5. In accordance with the revised procedure, the Central Accounts Section, Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur, may kindly be advised to pass on credit to the books of the **State Government of Madhya Pradesh** under intimation to this Department.

6. The expenditure involved is debitable to the Major Head '3601'-Grants in aid to State Governments. 3601.04-Grants for Centrally Sponsored Plan Scheme .3601.04.659-Environment Forestry and Wildlife -Wildlife Preservation 3601.04.659.03. Project Tiger 3601.04.659.03.00.31 Grants in aid under demand No. 30 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (Plan) for the year 2005-06.

7. This issues with the concurrence of the Forest Finance Division of the Department vide their Dy. No. 1512/AS (FA)/F/05 dated 31.10.2005 under the powers delegated to the Ministries/Departments.
