Sub: Centrally Sponsored Planned Scheme 'Project Tiger' – Administrative approval for Central Assistance release to Pench Tiger Reserve, Maharashtra during 2009-10 – Enhancement of scheme - regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the administrative approval of the competent authority to the enhancement of the Scheme from **Rs. 158.31 Lakhs (Rupees One Hundred Fifty Eight Lakhs and Thirty One Thousand only)** to **Rs. 159.402 Lakhs (Rupees One Hundred Fifty Nine Lakhs and Forty Thousand Two Hundred only)** in **Pench Tiger Reserve, Maharashtra** during the year 2009-10. The enhancement of amount of **Rs. 1.092 Lakhs (Rupees One Lakh and Nine Thousand Two Hundred only)** has been sanctioned for as Project allowance for field staff to Van – Majoor (Field Staff) as additional allocation for the year 2009-10.

2. I am also directed to convey the sanction of the competent authority to the release of an amount of **Rs. 1.092 Lakhs (Rupees One Lakh and Nine Thousand Two Hundred only)** to Government of Maharashtra during the current financial year 2009-10.

3. The terms and conditions governing the above release are the same as given in paras 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 of the sanction letter of even number dated 1st September, 2009.

4. The payment sanctioned above is provisional and is subject to the adjustment on the basis of the audited figures of expenditure. Other terms and conditions of the payment are as under:

- a) The grant is in accordance with the pattern of financial assistance approved by the Planning Commission and the Ministry of Finance.
- b) The grant sanctioned is subject to the adjustment on basis of the terms and conditions approving the scheme.

5. No deviation from the approved items of expenditure as enumerated in the annexure shall be made without prior concurrence of the Government of India. The guidelines for implementation of Project Tiger shall be fully adhered to. The Chief Wildlife warden and the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests of the State Government should be directed to ensure that the field works are in accordance with the Management plan and the Annual Plan of operation by the field inspections from time to time.

6. In accordance with the revised procedure, the Central Account Section, Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur, may kindly be advised to pass credit to the books of the **State Government of Maharashtra** under intimation to this Ministry.

7. The expenditure involved will be met from within the Sanctioned Budget Grants of Centrally Sponsored Project tiger Scheme under Demand No. 29, Ministry of Environment and Forests, Major Head 3601 – Grants-in-aid to the State Governments, 3601.04- Grants-in-aid for Centrally Sponsored Plan Scheme, 3601.04.659-Environmental Forestry and Wildlife – Wildlife Preservation, 3601.04.659.03- Project tiger, 3601.04.659.03.00.31- Grants-in-aid for the year 2009-10 (Plan).

8. This issues under the powers delegated to the Ministry and with the concurrence of Integrated Finance Division vide Dy. No. 881/DIR(IFD) dated 16.02.2010.
