Sub: Administrative approval and sanction of compensation to Forest Guard injured by tiger working in Sunderbans Tiger Reserve, West Bengal during 2010-11 under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Project Tiger.

Sir,

With reference to letter No. 1636/FD/2E-182 dated 10.06.2010 of the Government of West Bengal, Office of the Field Director, Sunderbans Tiger Reserve on the subject mentioned above. I am directed to convey the administrative approval and sanction of the competent authority to the release of an amount of Rs. 33,333/- (Rupees Thirty Three thousand Three hundred and Thirty Three only) to Government of West Bengal for payment as compensation to Shri Deb Nath Mondal, a Forest Guard injured by a tiger during the current financial year 2010-11.

2. As the annual budget of the Scheme is approved by the Central Government, the Government of Maharashtra is not required to furnish bond and sureties, in accordance with the Ministry of Finance O.M. No. 14(1)-EII(A)/64 dated 23.6.1965.

3. The payment sanctioned above is provisional and is subject to the adjustment on the basis of the audited figures of expenditure. Other terms and conditions of the payment are as under:

- (a) The compensation is in accordance with the pattern of financial assistance approved by the Planning Commission and the Ministry of Finance.
- (b) The compensation sanctioned is subject to the adjustment on the basis of the terms and conditions approving the scheme.

4. In accordance with the revised procedure, the Central Accounts Section, Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur, may kindly be advised to pass on credit to the books of the State Government of Maharashtra under intimation to this Department.

5. The expenditure involved will be met from within the Sanctioned Budget Grants of Centrally Sponsored Project tiger Scheme under Demand No. 30, Ministry of Environment and Forests, Major Head 3601 – Grants-in-aid to the State Governments, 3601.04- Grants-in-aid for Centrally Sponsored Plan Scheme, 3601.04.659-Environmental Forestry and Wildlife – Wildlife Preservation, 3601.04.659.03- Project tiger, 3601.04.659.03.00.31- Grants-in-aid for the year 2010-11 (Plan).

6. This issues under the powers delegated to the Ministry and with the concurrence of Integrated Finance Division vide Dy. No. 1872/Dir.(IFD/F.F.) dated 26.7.2010.
