Sub: Centrally Sponsored Planned Scheme 'Project Tiger' – Administrative approval for Central Assistance release to Ranthambhore Tiger Reserve, Rajasthan during 2011-12 – additional allocation towards ex-gratia payment.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the administrative approval of the competent authority for an amount of Rs. 60,000/- (Rupees Sixty Thousand only) sanctioned under Non-recurring activity towards ex-gratia payment to the legal heirs of the deceased Shri Daulat Singh Shekhawat, Assistant Conservator of Forests, Ranthambhore who was attacked by the tiger and seriously injured, while performing duty in Ranthambhore Tiger Reserve, as additional allocation for the year 2011-12.

2. I am also directed to convey the sanction of the competent authority for the release of an amount of Rs. 60,000/- (Rupees Sixty Thousand only) to the Government of Rajasthan for ex-gratia payment to Shri Daulat Singh Shekhawat, Assistant Conservator of Forests, Ranthambhore Tiger Reserve during the current financial year 2011-12.

3. The payment sanctioned above is provisional and is subject to the adjustment on the basis of the audited figures of expenditure. Other terms and conditions of the payment are as under:

- (a) The ex-gratia payment is in accordance with the pattern of financial assistance approved by the Planning Commission and the Ministry of Finance.
- (b) The payment sanctioned is subject to the adjustment on the basis of the terms and conditions approving the scheme.
- (c) The Utilization Certificate shall be furnished by the Department of Forest, Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur.

4. In accordance with the revised procedure, the Central Accounts Section, **Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur**, may kindly be advised to pass on credit to the books of the **State Government of Rajasthan** under intimation to this Authority.

5. The expenditure involved will be met from within the Sanctioned Budget Grants of Centrally Sponsored Project tiger Scheme under Demand No. 30, Ministry of Environment and Forests, Major Head 3601 – Grants-in-aid to the State Governments, 3601.04- Grants-in-aid for Centrally Sponsored Plan Scheme, 3601.04.659-Environmental Forestry and Wildlife - Wildlife Preservation, 3601.04.659.03- Project tiger, 3601.04.659.03.00.31- Grants-in-aid for the year 2011-12 (Plan).

6. This issues under the powers delegated to the Ministry and with the concurrence of Integrated Finance Division vide Dy. No. 1252/Dir. (IFD/F.F.) dated 22/11/2011.
